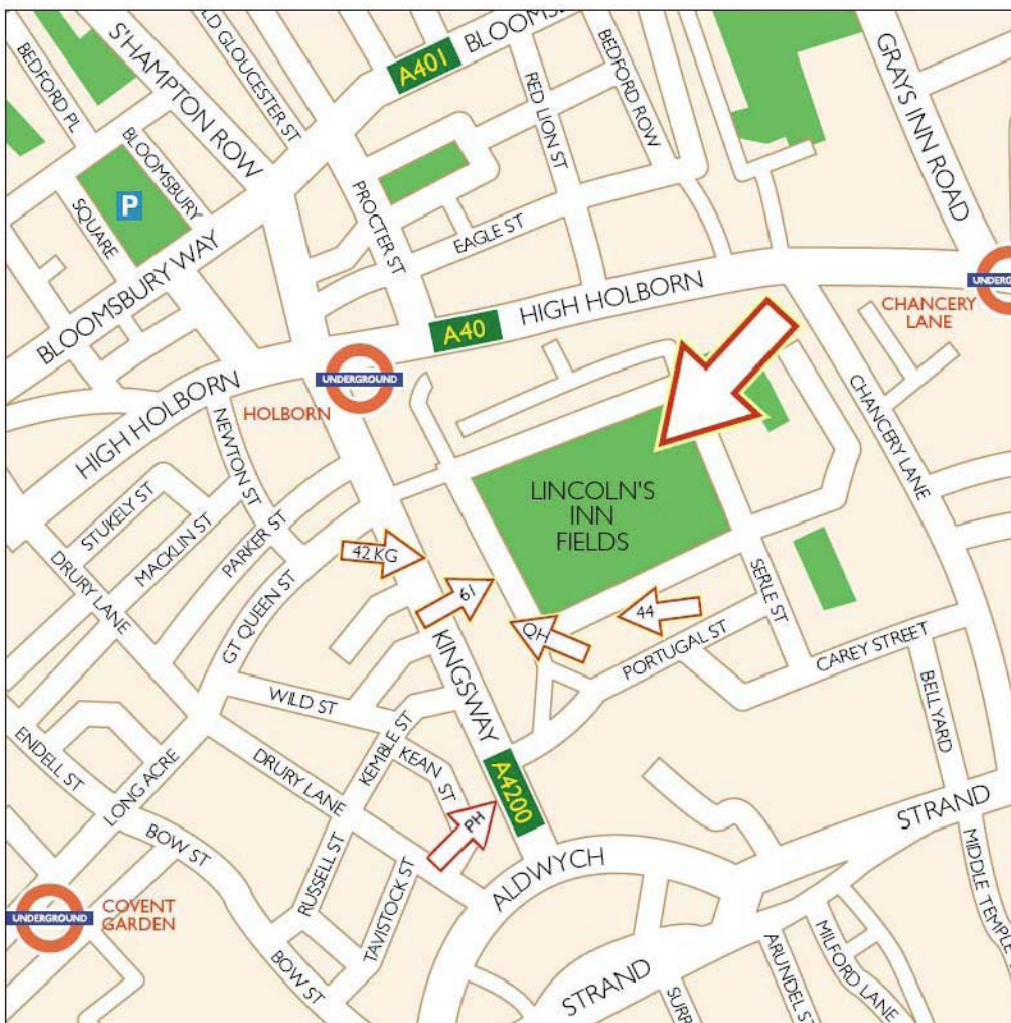

 For Nos.61 and 55 Queens House take the 3rd left – Remnant Street, then the next right. Cancer Research UK is on the right on the west side of the park.
 For 42 Kingsway just keep on walking up Kingsway. Number 42 is to your left.
