Pilot early phase trials training day - 7 July 2014

- Agenda topics include: Protocol interpretation; screening & recruitment; what is translational research; giving novel agents and links to palliative care
- As this is a pilot there will be detailed evaluation of the event to ensure that it contains the most relevant content and to see if and how it could be repeated
