Being an ECMC Nurse...

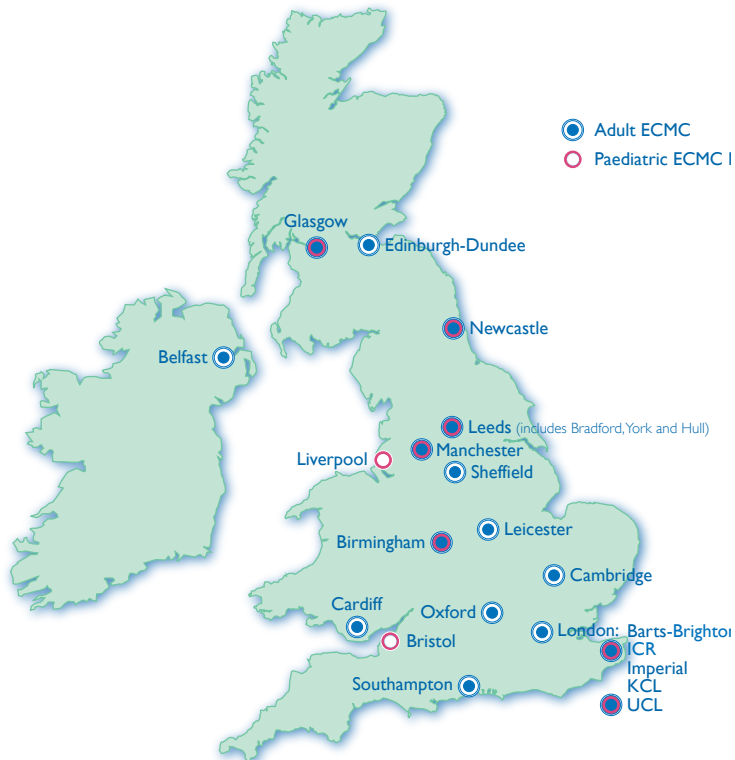
